# **Consider Joining Our Pack Committee**

In order to keep events and pack planning moving in the right direction we need your help. Please talk to one of the current pack leaders if you are interested in helping make Our Pack Go!

All Pack 40 Committee members are also BSA-registered adults with the Pack. As a registered and actively engaged adult, you can have a tremendous impact on the Pack program and have a lot of fun too! BSA regulations require "two-deep" leadership for all Scouting activities, which is, at least one trained adult (preferably but not always a Pack leader) and one other adult. More trained, registered adults and leaders will give us more flexibility. *As an active Committee member, you will also have a say in how the Pack is managed.* All adult registrants in the BSA are required to first complete an online course called "Youth Protection Training" which is offered by the BSA. You must also consent undergo a background check by the BSA. Upon completion of those requirements, you are registered. Additional online training explaining all of the duties is available and should be taken as soon as possible.
